**Kings Place** is a cultural hub, housing art galleries and performance spaces, within an award-winning building in Kings Cross. It's also the headquarters of The Night Shift's organisers, the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment.

**Purcell** (1659 – 1695) is widely considered one of the greatest English composers, credited with developing a uniquely English style of Baroque music.

**The Night Shift** is a series of late night events promoted by the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment and has included appearances at the Southbank Centre as well as smaller 'pub shows'. With its trademark laid back and informal atmosphere, the project aims to bring classical performance to a younger audience.
