Old-school orchestra play progressive gay club night



The Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment, world-renowned period instrument specialists, are booked to play one of London's longest running alternative club nights.

The performance at post-queer collective DUCKIE's regular Saturday night event forms part of the

Orchestra's revolutionary rule-breaking classical music series, The Night Shift. A quartet, formed of the OAE's players, will play a programme of Baroque music, making it the first time a classical act, let alone a group with the OAE's global reputation, has performed at the night.

DUCKIE is renowned for its varied and experimental acts but this evening, with another performance from unpredictable and often-nude performance artist Katy Baird, promises to be unusual in the extreme.
